

Where Was Atlantis



THE LOST CITY OF ATLANTIS. The legend of the Lost City of Atlantis is one of history's most enduring myths; and from the words of one man, Plato, the story of the ancient city state, has grown. One of the most common theories put forward for the location of Atlantis is the Black Sea. If Atlantis is found, how can we verify its correct location? Plato gave us the story of Atlantis, but during the time it flourished as a kingdom, sailors in Europe were not. A National Geographic documentary called 'Atlantis Rising', by Titanic director James Cameron, charts a search for the lost city (artist's). Some believe the Atlantis myth was inspired by the Black Sea floods of around 7000 BC - an event that may have also generated the flood. Most Atlantologists have sited Atlantis in the Atlantic Ocean. And the rest, with a few exceptions, have placed the lost continent in the Mediterranean. Check out six of the most notable theories about the lost civilization of Atlantis, one of the most enduring legends in history. I have noted before that the answer depends on what one means by Atlantis. Plato's story was certainly influenced by the rise and fall of the Minoan civilisation. You are right there are problems dating Atlantis from the Egyptian story. The Egyptians mentioned 9,000 years whereas in fact there was only 3,600 years before. SCIENTISTS have discovered a forgotten ancient city in the middle of the Pacific Ocean which could turn out to be Atlantis. What has kept the myth of Atlantis for so many thousands of years? In one cataclysmic night, the gods sent a battalion of fire and earthquakes so intense that the Utopian kingdom of Atlantis sank deep into the sea. For centuries, historians, archaeologists and scuba divers have sought and failed over and over again to find Atlantis, the glorious ancient. Let's say Atlantis did in fact exist thousands or hundreds of years ago, that Plato did not make up the story about the great Atlantean. Where is it? There have been many locations proposed for the location of mythical Atlantis. Some are more or less serious attempts at legitimate scholarly or archaeological.
